- We had to find suitable international partners around the world

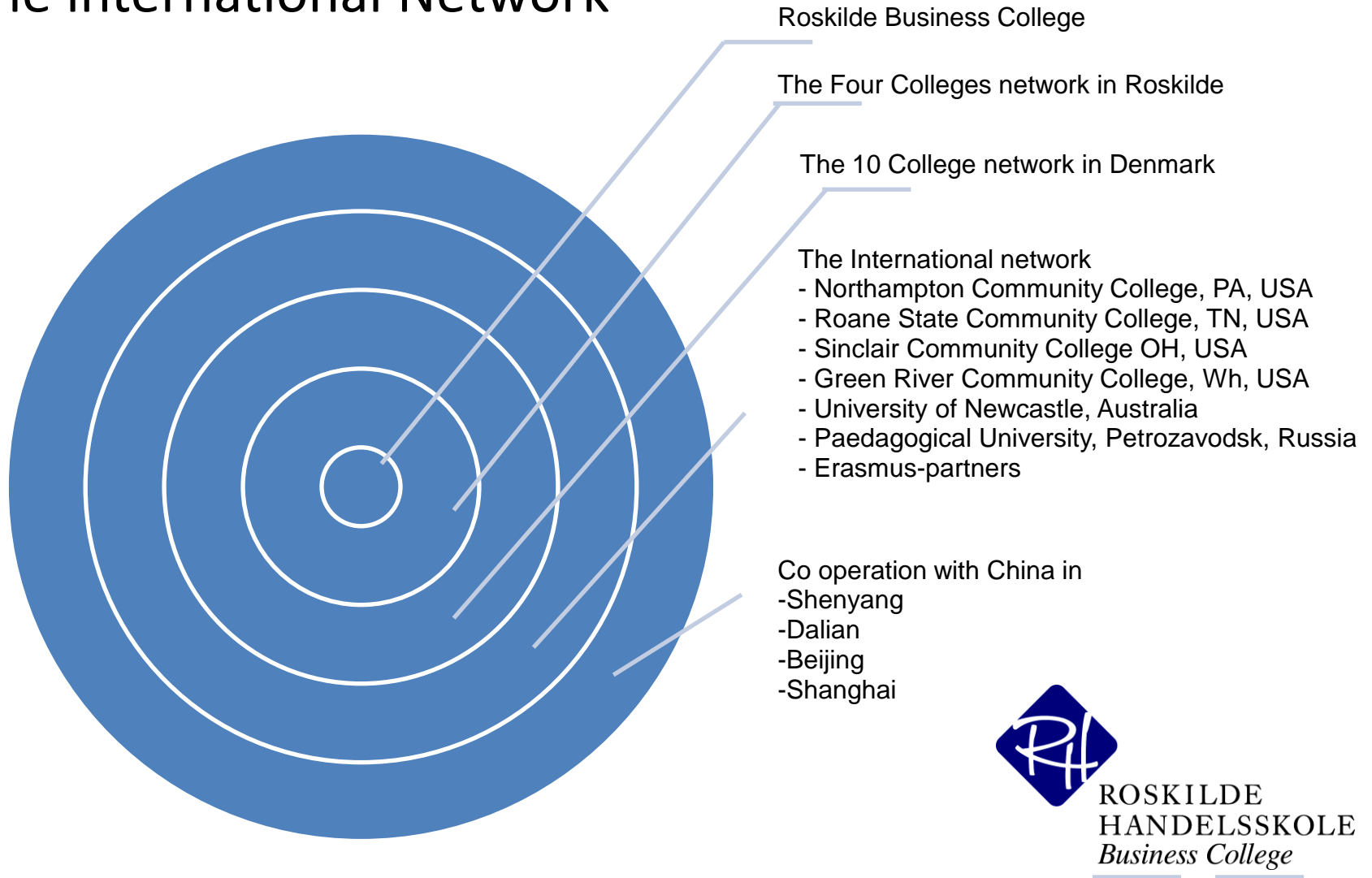


Our network of partners

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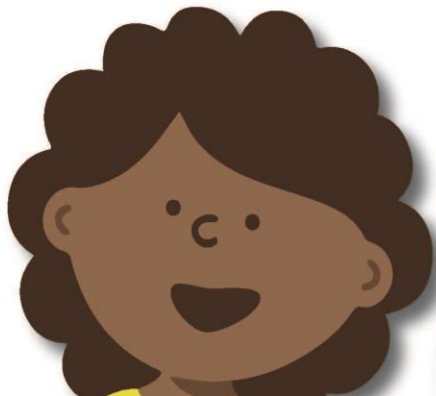
